A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY
MONROE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Monroe Township (“Township”) currently owns a 1948 Ford F6 Truck (“Truck”), said Truck having been purchased new in 1948; and

WHEREAS, the Truck had served the community in and around the Township for many years prior to the transfer of ownership to a Township resident; and

WHEREAS, the Township re-assumed ownership of the Truck in 2002, and the Township Road Crew devoted many hours into the restoration of the Truck in order to restore it to its original condition; and

WHEREAS, the Township has kept the restored Truck in the Township Building Complex’s garage; and

WHEREAS, the Williams Grove Historical Steam Engine Association (“WGHSEA”) is a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving steam powered equipment and educating the public about the history of farming; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to transfer ownership of the Truck to WGHSEA, where the Truck will be cared for and appreciated as a locally accessible antique display piece; and

WHEREAS, The Second Class Township Code (53 P. S. §§ 65101, *et seq.*) authorizes the Township Board of Supervisors to sell the Truck without advertisement or bidding if the buyer is a nonprofit corporation established for the preservation of historical artifacts, 53 P.S. § 66504.


NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned Township Board of Supervisors do hereby approve the sale of the 1948 Ford F6 Truck to the Williams Grove Historical Steam Engine Association for the sum of ONE AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$1.00), the payment of which is hereby acknowledged.
